Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. Within thirty days after this act shall take effect, the governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, if it be then in session, shall appoint from the different parts of the state nine physicians, who shall be men of good moral character and temperate habits, distinguished for their devotion to the study of medicine and allied sciences, of not less than seven years continuous practice in their profession, and each of whom shall be a graduate of a respectable medical college; and said nine physicians, when so appointed and confirmed, shall be known as The Kansas State Board of Health. Three of said physicians shall be appointed for one year, three for two years, and three for three years; and annually...
