

Within two minutes, my friend managed to let these men know that she was an incest survivor. Her admission had nothing whatsoever to do with the conversation we d been having, and in a flash I realized that she was using her wounds as leverage. She had gotten to the point that she defined herself by a negative experience. Once Myss became attuned to this phenomenon, which she quickly dubbed woundology, she saw it everywhere.
